


**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
REEDYMOOR LANE, FOULRIDGE, PENDLE BOROUGH  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Reedymoor Lane, Foulridge from outside property named The Old Hatchery to outside property number 10 Reedymoor Terrace.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> December 2024 until 1700 hours on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Smithy Lane – Red Lane – Langroyd Road – Skipton New Road – Causeway – Higher Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the installation of joint cable for a new service connection to be carried out.
