(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of vehicle to proceed over that length of Lower Mead Drive, Burnley from outside substation in as South Westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 09:00 hours to 14:00 hours on Thursday 23rd January 2025 or until completion of the works within this Period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic (except HGVs) affected by the closure is via:- Lower Mead Drive – Lower Manor Lane – Lower Mead Drive and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow parking for wagons to lift switchgear into the substation undertaken by Network Plus
