

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(SANDY LANE, HAMBLETON, WYRE BOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF
WAITING) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:

- a) Sandy Lane, Hambleton, the north east side, from its junction with the centreline of Pauls Lane to its junction with the centreline of Stoney Lane;
- b) Sandy Lane, Hambleton, the south west side, from its junction with the projected centreline of Pauls Lane for a distance of 36.5 metres in a north westerly then south westerly direction.
