COUNTY OF LANCASHIRE**

PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY (DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION) (NO.6) ORDER 2010

This Order is made by Lancashire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act, 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that Authority that The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) namely the discovery by the Surveying Authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, namely a public footpath.

The Authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. Lancashire County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order, the "relevant date" is the 12 May 2010.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Public Rights of Way (Definitive Map Modification) (No.6) Order 2010.

DESCRIPTION OF PATH TO BE ADDED

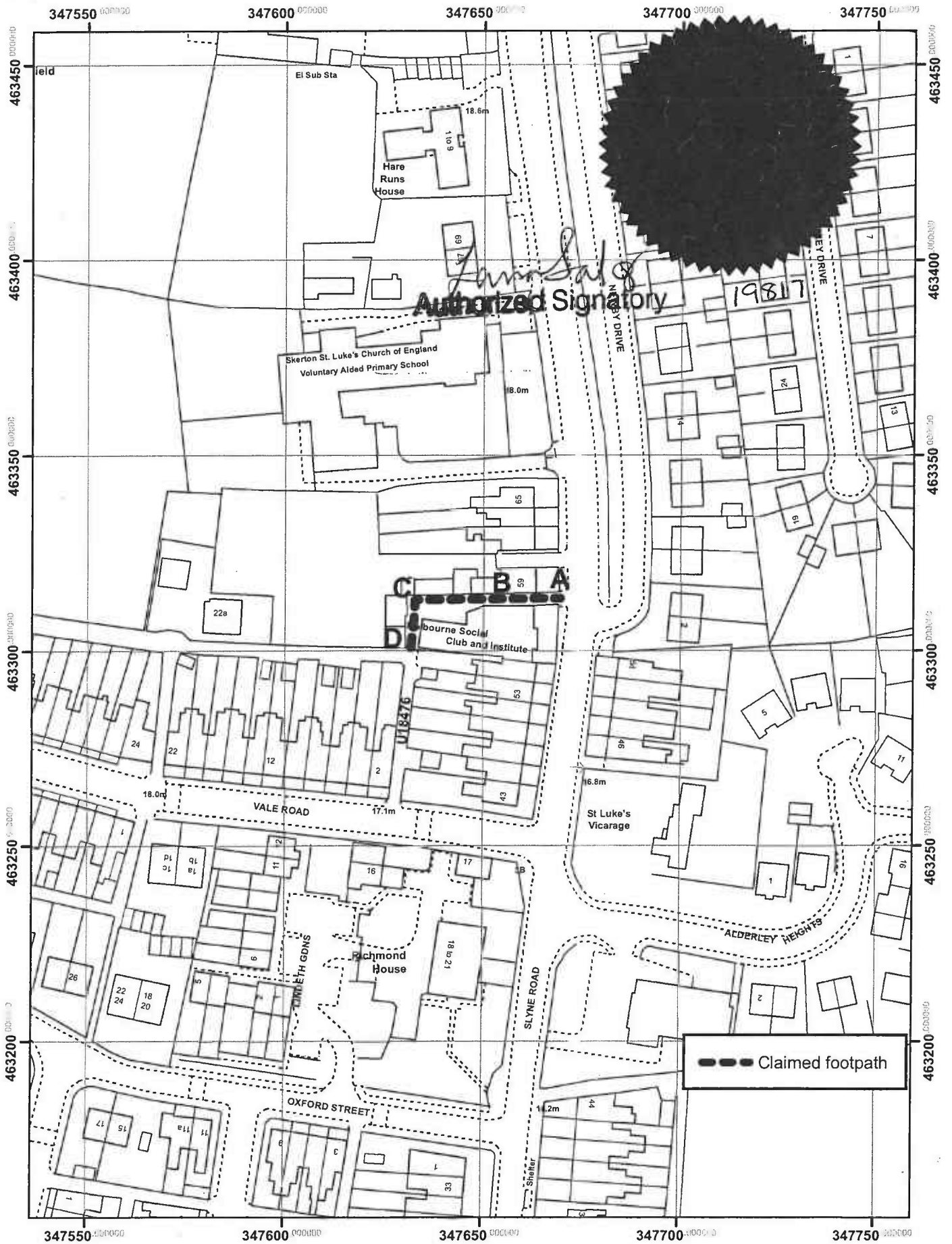
A Public Footpath from a point on Slyne Road A6, between 59 Slyne Road and Melbourne Social Club, City of Lancaster, running with a width of 2.5 metres in a westerly direction on a tarmac surface for a distance of approximately 16 metres, where the width is restricted by a set of steps to 2.3 metres. The footpath continues in a westerly direction with a width of 3 metres for a distance of approximately 24 metres and then continues in a southerly direction with a width of 3 metres for a distance of approximately 12 metres. A total distance of approximately 52 metres and shown between points A – B – C – D on the Order Plan.

The footpath continues in a westerly direction with a width of 3 metres for a distance of approximately 24 metres to grid reference SD 4763 6331 and continues with a width of 3 metres in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 12 metres to grid reference SD 4763 6330, a total distance of approximately 52 metres.

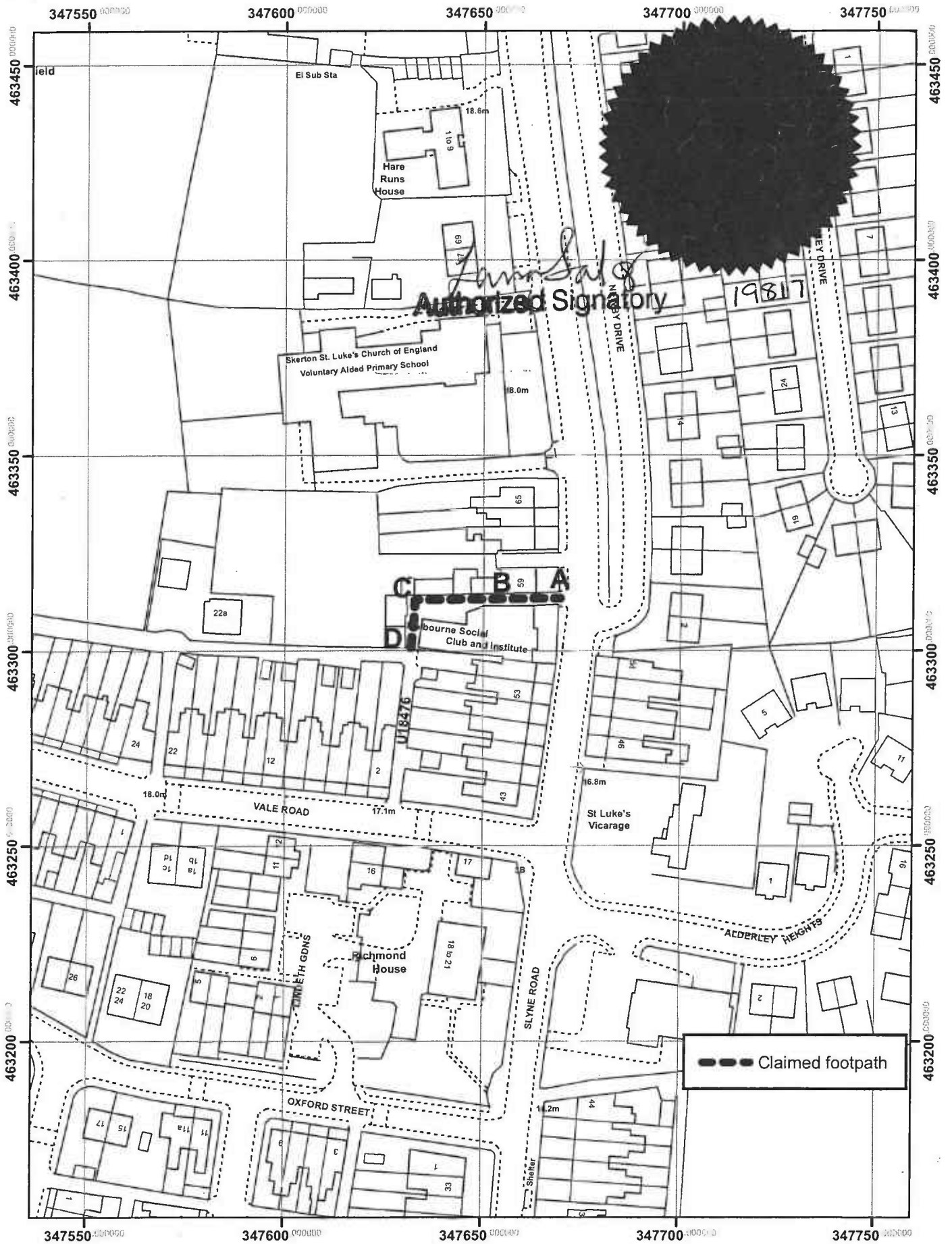
