
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 65(1) AND 66(4) PROPOSED SHARED USE CYCLE WAY



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with Section 65(1) and 66(4) of the Highways Act 1980 Lancashire County Council propose to convert the following lengths of footway to joint use cycleways:-

- a) Market Street, Bacup, the east side, from its junction with the centreline of Henrietta Street for a distance of 42 metres in a southerly direction;
- b) Henrietta Street, Bacup, the south side from its junction with the centreline of Market Street for a distance of 123 metres in an easterly direction



Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this proposal is to provide a shared use path allowing pedestrians and cycles to safely travel from the development to the east side of Market Street. This will improve and encourage sustainable transport in and between local businesses, employment, and recreation. These proposals are being funded by Section 278 monies by the developer and are linked to the new retail development.
