Concerns have been raised by residents regarding parked vehicles at the junction of South Avenue and Chapel Lane, New Longton causing sightline issues for vehicles turning onto Chapel Lane from South Avenue.

To address the issue, it is proposed to introduce No Waiting At Any Time restrictions to prohibit parking at the junction of South Avenue and Chapel Lane.

The County Councillor for the area is in support of the proposal.
