(OXFORD STREET, TOWNLEY STREET, MORECAMBE, LANCASTER CITY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of roads;-
 - i. Oxford Street, Morecambe from its junction with Rose Street to its junction with Townley Street.
 - ii. Townley Street, Morecambe from its junction with Oxford Street to its junction with Lucy Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 13th January 2025 until 1630 hours on Sunday 9th February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Vehicular access for residents will be available most days between 1800 hours and 0700 hours, however parking will be limited.
5. An alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the closure are via:-
 - i. Rose Street – Lord Street – Poulton Road – Clarence Street – Morecambe Street West – Green Street – Clark Street – Lucy Street.
 - ii. Lucy Street – Clark Street – Green Street – Poulton Road – Oxford Street.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow electricity substation maintenance works to be carried out.
