

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

(SHORE ROAD, WARTON, LANCASTER CITY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Shore Road, Warton from its junction with Warton Road to its junction with Crag Bank Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative on the following times and dates, or until the completion of the works within this period;
  - i. From 2200 hours on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> January 2025, until 0600 hours on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> January 2025.
  - ii. From 2000 hours on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> January 2025 until 0600 hours on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2025.
4. Access for Emergency Service Vehicles will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
5. An alternative route for pedestrians, cycles and vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Crag Bank Lane – Crag Bank Road – A6 Min Road – A6 Lancaster Road – Haws Hill – Warton Rod and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow safe access for the installation of monitoring equipment to the railway bridge.
