(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(b)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over the full lengths of Linton Street, Ainslie Road and Balfour Street, Preston.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Tuesday 26th November 2024 until 2359 hours on Friday 20th December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Nothing in Article 1 of this Notice shall make it unlawful to proceed over the said road if the vehicle is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said road;
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow road linng removals and road marking works to be carried out.
