(MAIN STREET, OVERTON, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (No.3) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Main Street, Overton from outside property known as Boldmead to outside property no.33.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2025 until 1700 hours on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents and emergency service vehicles will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Main Street – Pedder Road – Pedder Grove – Main Street and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the disconnection of the old lead water supply and connection of new supply.
