(B5272 GARSTANG ROAD, COCKERHAM, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER (No.2) 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of B5272 Garstang Road, Cockerham from its junction with Crookhey Gardens to outside property know as Old Crookhey Farm.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2100 hours on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> January 2025 until 0600 hours on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Emergency Services access will be maintained when safe passage permits.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: B5272 Garstang Road Cockerham Road A6 Lancaster Road –
  Ratcliffe Wharf Lane B5272 Park Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow safe access to underground structure to allow fibre pulling and de-silting works to take place on behalf of Openreach.
