(BEACH STREET, MORECAMBE, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Beech Street, Morecambe from its junction with A5105 Marine Road East to its junction with New Market Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily between 0900 hours and 1700 hours from Monday 27<sup>th</sup> January 2025 until Sunday 9th February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents and Emergency Service Vehicles will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-New Market Street- Princess Crescent – A5105 Marine Road East and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation works to be carried out to replace asset on behalf of Electricity North West.
