
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of St Michaels Lane, Bolton le Sands from its junction with Hilcrest Avenue to its junction with Old Station Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 3rd March 2025 until 1700 hours on Thursday 20th March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access for Emergency Services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Sunnybank Road – Mill Lane – A6 Main Road – St Michaels Lane
and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow safe working while works to replace gas main are carried out.
