(OAKENCLOUGH ROAD, NETHER WYRESDALE, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Oakenclough Road, Nether Wyresdale from the property "Calder Side" for approximately 45 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 27th January 2025 until 1700 hours on Friday 31st January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Bleasdale Lane <> Hobbs Lane <> Butt Hill Lane <> Smithy Lane <> Lodge Road <> New Lane <> Preston Lancaster Road <> Garstang Road <> Bonds Lane <> (North bound diversion must then take Park Hill Rd onto Croston Road) & (South bound diversion must then take High St then onto Market Place) <> Bridge Lane <> B6430 <> Lancaster Road <> Hollins Lane <> Stony Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new water connection works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
