## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(PARK LANE & BROAD LANE, WINMARLEIGH, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Borough of Wyre:
  - i. Park Lane from its junction with Broad Lane for approximately 200 metres in a northerly direction.
  - ii. Broad Lane from its junction with Park Lane to the junction with Church Lane & New House Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative **daily** from 0930 hours to 1500 hours on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2025 until Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Church Lane – Island Lane - Garstang Road – Lancaster Road – Marsh Lane – Main Street – Garstang Road – Park Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow BT Openreach engineers safe access to overhead and underground structures.
