## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(RAWCLIFFE ROAD, ST MICHAELS, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rawcliffe Road, St Michaels from its junction with Garstang Road to its junction with Paddington Avenue.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours until 1530 hours on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Town End – Whin Lane – Mill Lane – Bull Park Lane – Mains Lane – Garstang New Road – Garstang Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telegraph pole replacement works to be carried out by BT Openreach.
