Wraparound social media suggestions for providers

Background

We know many working families with primary school children need before or after-school childcare known as 'wraparound'.

Wraparound covers provision for pupils in England during term time between 8am and 6pm, including breakfast clubs, sports clubs or music groups.

As part of the government's biggest childcare investment, they're increasing the number of wraparound childcare places, available nationwide from September.

- If eligible, you can use Tax-Free Childcare or Universal Credit Childcare to help pay for wraparound childcare.


