RILEY STREET, EARBY, PENDLE BORUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Riley Street, Earby from its junction with Stoney Bank Road for approximately 25 metres in southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1430 hours on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Stoney Bank Road – Water Street – Aspen Lane – Chapel Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the replacement of defective tarmac around manhole frame and cover to be carried out.
