**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Rear 60 to 102 Victoria Road, Padiham from approximately its junction with Spenser Street, Padiham to approximately its junction with Shakespeare Street, Padhiham.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1320 hours on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> December 2024 until 2359 hours on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent repair and replacement works for a leaking stop tap to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
