

NOTICE OF MAKING
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CALDER AVENUE, LONGRIDGE, RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH)
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 28 November 2024 Lancashire County Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

1. Introduce a prohibition of waiting in Calder Avenue, Longridge, the north west side, from a point 140 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Cherry Grove for a distance of 26 metres in a north easterly direction.
2. Introduce a restriction of waiting between 8am and 6pm in Calder Avenue, Longridge, the south east side, from a point 140 metres north east of its junction with the projected centreline of Cherry Grove for a distance of 26 metres in a north easterly direction.

This Order will come into force on the 13 December 2024. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
