**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of C118 Brookfield Lane, Aughton from approximately the Northern boundary of the property named Brookfield House for an approximate distance of 100m in a Southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0000 hours on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2024 until 2359 hours on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow emergency repair works to a carriageway collapse to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
