 - Thistle Street from its junction with Bankside Lane to its junction with Rose Street
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1300 hours until 2359 hours on Friday 6th December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the urgent repair to damaged cables to be carried out.
