BURNLEY ROAD, TRAWDEN, PENDLE BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicles to proceed over that length of Burnley Road, Trawden from outside St Marys Vicarage to outside New Laith Farm.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1700 hours on Tuesday 7th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Shelfield Lane – Back Lane – Southfield Lane – Knotts Lane – Bridge Street – Albert Road – Church Street – Market Street – Keighley Road – Cotton Tree Lane – Trawden Road – Skipton Road – Church Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the replacement of a damaged pole to be carried out.
