



BURNLEY ROAD, TRAWDEN, PENDLE BOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicles to proceed over that length of Burnley Road, Trawden from outside St Marys Vicarage to outside New Laith Farm.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1700 hours on Tuesday 7th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Shelfield Lane – Back Lane – Southfield Lane – Knotts Lane – Bridge Street – Albert Road – Church Street – Market Street – Keighley Road – Cotton Tree Lane – Trawden Road – Skipton Road – Church Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the replacement of a damaged pole to be carried out.
