LOWER HOUSE LANE, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Lowerhouse Lane, Burnley from outside number 332 Lowerhouse Lane in a westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1900 hours on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> January 2025 to 07:00 hours on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Lower House Lane North – Scott Street – Kiddrow Lane – Liverpool Road – Lower House Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow substation maintenance undertaken by North Star Estates Ltd on behalf of Electricity North West Ltd
