(RED LANE, ECCLESTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Red Lane, Eccleston from a point 30m Northwest of the access to Wood End Farm to a point 145m Southwest of the access to Bradley Hall Farm.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1700 hours on Monday 6th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Bradley Lane, Eccleston – The Green, Eccleston – Langton Brow, Eccleston – Wood Lane, Heskin – Park Hall Road, Heskin – Park Hall Road, Charnock Richard – Mill Lane, Heskin – Preston Road, Charnock Richard and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow damaged pole replacement works to be carried out by Dutton Traffic Management in conjunction with BT.
