(KELLET ROAD, OVER KELLET, LANCASTER CITY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (No.2) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Kellet Road, Over Kellet from the private entrance road to Green Bank Farm to outside the former Post Office.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative 0800 hours until 1700 hours on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents and Emergency Services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Kellet Road – Nether Kellet Road – Main Road – Back Lane – Kellet Road and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to excavate and lay High Voltage electric cable from new site to point of connection to be carried out.
