

## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(LEYLAND LANE, LEYLAND, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Leyland Lane, Leyland from Mill Lane, Leyland to the southern boundary of property number 309.


**AND FURTHER**, temporarily suspend the Southbound one-way restriction on Leyland Lane, Leyland from U47571 Dunkirk Lane, Leyland to B5248 Slater Lane, Leyland.

2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2025 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Cyclists to be instructed to dismount and walk along the footway in the closure area.**
4. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

U47571 Dunkirk Lane, Leyland – B5248 Dunkirk Lane, Leyland –  
B5253 Schleswig Way, Moss Side – U5702 Slater Lane, Leyland –  
B5248 Slater Lane, Leyland.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow damaged culvert repair works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
