(SAUNDERS LANE, HUTTON, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Saunders Lane, Hutton from the northern boundary of the property named Cullan to the southern boundary of the property named Rosedale Cottage.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 6th January 2025 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 8th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. Alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the closure are via:-

Clockwise Diversion

A59 Longton Bypass, Hutton – A59 Longton Bypass, Longton – Chapel Lane, New Longton

Anticlockwise Diversion

Chapel Lane, New Longton – Chapel Park Road, Longton – Chapel Lane, Longton – A59 Longton Bypass, Longton – A59 Longton Bypass, Hutton northbound to Liverpool Road Roundabout – A59 Longton Bypass, Hutton southbound from Liverpool Road Roundabout

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new water connection installation works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
