(C133 NARROW MOSS LANE, SCARISBRICK, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of C133 Narrow Moss Lane, Ormskirk from the northwestern boundary of the property named Moss View Cottage to the access road to the property named Brooklands Cottage.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Thursday 9th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

C133 Narrow Moss Lane, Ormskirk – U1070 Heskin Lane, Ormskirk – A570 Southport Road, Ormskirk – A59 County Road, Ormskirk – A59 High Lane, Orsmkirk – B5242 Pippin Street, Burscough – B5242 Barrison Green, Scarisbrick – C133 Moorfield Lane, Scarisbrick – C133 Narrow Moss Lane, Scarisbrick and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole replacement works to be carried out by Sunbelt Rentals Ltd on behalf of BT.
