


**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
RIDING BARN STREET, CHURCH, HYNDBURN BOROUGH  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Riding Barn Street, Church from its junction of Hyndburn Road for a distance of 85 metres in a Southerly direction
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 08:00 hours on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> February 2025 to 16:00 hours on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. <Closure conditions (including for example overnight closures only)> **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.** <Closure conditions (including for example overnight closures only)>
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic (except HGVs) affected by the closure is via:- Riding Barn Street – Buckingham Grove – St Nicholas Road – Manor Place – Hyndburn Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow gas mains replacement works undertaken by Cadent Gas on behalf of Network Plus
