(RAIKES ROAD, THORNTON CLEVELEYS, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Raikes Road, Thornton Cleveleys from its junction with Stanah Road to its junction with Underbank Road.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours on Monday 6th January 2025 until 1730 hours on Sunday 18th May 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Lambs Road – Stanah Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Section 50 works for installation of mains sewers and drainage to be carried out by MV Kelly on behalf of Wain Homes.
