


**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
RED LANE, COLNE, PENDLE BOROUGH  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any Red Lane, Colne to proceed over that length of Red Lane, Colne from approximately 90 metres in a westerly direction from property named Parkfield Stables for 10 metres.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2025 until 1700 hours on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Barnoldswick Road – Standing Lane – Whitemoor Road – High Lane – Causeway – Skipton New Road – Langroyd Road – Red Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow repairs to the railway bridge to be carried out.
