
RED LANE, COLNE, PENDLE BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any Red Lane, Colne to proceed over that length of Red Lane, Colne from approximately 90 metres in a westerly direction from property named Parkfield Stables for 10 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2025 until 1700 hours on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Barnoldswick Road – Standing Lane – Whitemoor Road – High Lane – Causeway – Skipton New Road – Langroyd Road – Red Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow repairs to the railway bridge to be carried out.
