**MOSELEY ROAD AND HUFLING LANE, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of vehicle to proceed over that length of Moseley Road and Hufing Lane, Burnley from 20 meter either side of Towneley Level Crossing.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative nightly from 2330 hours until 0730 on the dates specified below;
 - i. Saturday 18th January 2025 until Sunday 19th January 2025.
 - ii. Saturday 25th January 2025 until Sunday 26th January 2025.
 - iii. Saturday 8th February 2025 until Sunday 9th February 2025.
 - iv. Saturday 15th February 2025 until Sunday 16th February 2025.
 - v. Saturday 22nd February 2025 until Sunday 23rd February 2025.
 - vi. Saturday 1st March 2025 until Sunday 2nd March 2025.

or until completion of the works within this period.

4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Moseley Road – Woodlumpston Road – Hufing Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow rerailing works and hand tool accessing and egressing at Towneley Level Crossing works undertaken by Centurion Site Services on behalf of Network Rail.
