ABBAY STREET, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN BOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Abbey Street, Accrington from its junction of Avenue Parade for a distance of 260 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.

The prohibition will be operative daily from 08:00 hours to 18:00 hours from Friday 28th February 2025 to Monday 17th March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.

Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.


Closure conditions (including for example overnight closures only)

The prohibition will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

3. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Abbey Street – Avenue Parade and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out on behalf of Lancashire County Council
