**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council considers it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Westgate, Burnley from the side of Belle Vue Mill for 10 metres in either direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1400 hours on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> December 2024 until 1200 hours on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> December or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow immediate renewal of leaking service and to complete backfill and reinstatement works to be carried out.
