(U47378 AVELING DRIVE, BANKS, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U47378 Aveling Drive, Banks from a point 60m West of the western boundary of the property Mossband Farm to a point 35m East of the eastern boundary at the rear of 12 Sycamore Close, Banks.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> January 2025 until 1700 hours on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

U1268 Square House Lane, Banks – U1269 Gorsey Lane, Banks – C142 Chapel Lane, Banks – C142 Bonds Lane, Banks – C142 Church Road, Banks – C140 Hoole Lane, Banks – C140 Guinea Hall Lane, Banks and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow defect remedial works in the carriageway to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West.
