(U400 LORD STREET, BURSCOUGH, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U400 Lord Street, Burscough from U399 School Lane, Burscough to U402 Stanley Court, Burscough.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Monday 20th January 2025 until 1730 hours on Tuesday 28th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.**
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

U400 Lord Street, Burscough – A59 Liverpool Road North, Burscough – U399 School Lane, Burscough and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new gas service installation works to be carried out by Cadent Gas.
