(MARKET STREET, CHORLEY, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Market Street, Chorley from High Street, Chorley to Fazakerley Street, Chorley.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1500 hours on Monday 20th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Market Street, Chorley – Union Street, Chorley – Clifford Street, Chorley - Shepherds Way, Chorley - George Street, Chorley

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the safe unloading of materials to be carried out by Ventbrook Traffic Management in conjunction KKC UK.
