NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of
 - i. **Back New Road, Earby** from its junction with Victoria Road to its junction with Back 41-69 Victoria Road.
 - ii. **Victoria Road, Earby** from its junction with New Road to its junction with Back New Road.
 - iii. **Albert Street, Earby** from its junction with Victoria Road to the Gable end of property 7 Victoria Road.
 - iv. **Edward Street, Earby** from its junction with Victoria Road to its junction with Back 41-69 Victoria Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from.
 - i. **Back New Road** from 0800 hours on Monday 6th January 2025 until 1600 hours on Friday 17th January 2025
 - ii. **Victoria Road** from 0800 hours on Monday 6th January 2025 until 1600 hours on Friday 21st March 2025
 - iii. **Albert Street** from 0800 hours on Thursday 27th February 2025 until 1600 hours on Friday 7th March 2025
 - iv. **Edward Street** from 0800 hours on Monday 10th March 2025 until 1600 hours on Friday 21st March 2025

or until completion of the works within this period


- 4. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any Vehicle to wait or wait for the purposes of Loading or Unloading in the lengths of road set out in Article as below.
 - Victoria Road, Earby on Monday 20th January 2025 until Friday 14th February 2025.
- 5. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions

2016. Works are weather dependent and may be carried out on any of the dates specified.

6. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Earby United Kingdom Shared Prosperity Fund (upgrade of town centre) works to be carried out.
