(BACK HAVE LOCK ROAD, PENWORTHAM, SOUTH RIBBLE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Back Have Lock Road, Penwortham from the rear of property number 19 Fairhaven Road, to its junction with Back Have Lock Road
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2025 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

This is a no-through road – No diversion required.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow water connection works to be carried out.
