(GRANGE LANE, HUTTON, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Grange Lane, Hutton from approximately the north west boundary of the property named Ravenstone to approximately the north west boundary of the property 4 Airey Houses.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1155 hours on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> December 2024 until 2359 hours on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for traffic is not possible owing to the fact that Grange Lane, Hutton is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent repair works to a loss of service to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
