

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CHESTER ROAD SCHEME, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Borough of Preston City:

Chester Road, Preston for the full length	Andrew Street, Preston for the full length
Ludwidge Avenue, Preston for the full length	Dodgson Road, Preston for the full length
Eccles Street, Preston for the full length	Dodgson Place, Preston for the full length
Sellers Street, Preston for the full length	Ansdell Street, Preston for the full length
Poynter Street, Preston for the full length	Collinson Street, Preston for the full length
Landseer Street, Preston for the full length	Holman Street, Preston for the full length
Fletcher Road, Preston from its junction with Chester Road to its junction with West View.	

Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.

2. The Order will be in force from daily from 0900 hours until 1500 hours on Monday 6th January 2025 until Wednesday 8th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
3. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be locally signed.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow surface dressing patching works to be carried out.
