NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Clifton Street, Lytham St Annes from its junction with Station Road to outside house No 3 Clifton Street.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 24th March 2025 until 1800 hours on Wednesday 26th March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Station Road > Park View Road > Ballam Road > Park Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to rebuild a water asset chamber to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
