WHITTINGHAM LANE, GRIMSARGH, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Whittingham Lane, Grimsargh from its junction with Cow Hill to approximately 400 metres in a northerly direction outside of Savick House.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> February 2025 until Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Haighton Green Lane – Durton Lane – Eastway – Watling Street Road – Gamull Lane – Longridge Road – Whittingham Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Telecoms work to be carried out.
