WHITTINGHAM LANE, GRIMSARGH, PRESTON CITY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Whittingham Lane, Grimsargh from its junction with Cow Hill to approximately 400 metres in a northerly direction outside of Savick House.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Monday 17th February 2025 until Tuesday 18th February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Haighton Green Lane – Durton Lane – Eastway – Watling Street Road – Gamull Lane – Longridge Road – Whittingham Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Telecoms work to be carried out.
