## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(BUCKHOLES LANE, WHEELTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Buckholes Lane, Wheelton from the northwestern boundary of the property named Woodruff Farm to the southwestern boundary of property number 136.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1600 hours on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

School Lane, Brinscall – Railway Road, Brinscall – Railway Road, Withnell – Bury Lane, Withnell – Chorley Road, Withnell – Blackburn Road, Higher Wheelton – Bett Lane, Higher Wheelton and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow vegetation management works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West.
