(BACK STATION ROAD 320 TO 326, BAMBER BRIDGE, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Back Station Road 320 to 326, Bamber Bridge from Co-operative Street, Bamber Bridge to Back Co-operative Street, Bamber Bridge.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2025 until 1615 hours on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access, including for emergency services, will not be maintained due to the nature of the works being undertaken.
- 4. An alternative route for all traffic affected by the closure is not possible owing to the fact the affected section of Back Station Road 320 to 326, Bamber Bridge is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow mandatory gas disconnection works on grounds of safety to members of the public to be carried out by Cadent Gas.
