(SPODDEN FOLD, WHITWORTH, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under Section 14(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Spodden Fold, Whitworth from approximately its junction with Hall Street, Whitworth to approximately the southwestern boundary of property number 2.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1025 hours on Tuesday 31st December 2024 until 2359 hours on Saturday 4th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for traffic affected by the closure is not possible owing to the fact that Spodden Fold, Whitworth is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent repair works to consequential damage caused by water main leak to be carried out by Lancashire County Council and United Utilities.
